

Sajda Sahw Amendment Prostration

Performed after one salām to the right *after a wājib action has been missed*, done additionally, or done out of its proper sequence. Examples of *wājib actions* are:

- 1 To recite Surat al-Fātihah in each rak'ah when performing Salāh alone
- 2 To recite three short verses or one long verse after Surat al-Fātihah
- 3 To recite audibly in Fajr, Maghrib and 'Ishā' when leading the prayer
- 4 To recite silently in Zuhr and 'Asr
- 5 To sit after two raka'āt in a four raka'āt prayer
- 6 To recite the tahiyah and tashahhud during the sitting
- 7 To do the qunūt in the witr prayer
- 8 To perform six additional takbirs in both 'Īd prayers

*If any of these are missed
you must do Sajda Sahw*
